Re-Registration for 2017-2018 School Year

You also should have received an email welcoming you to our new online enrollment and re-registration process. Completion of the online enrollment process secures a seat for your child(ren). You should have received a separate email for <u>each</u> child who will be attending SDSC. This email was sent from <u>support@tads.com</u>. It included a brief overview of the registration process and a link unique to your child's information for enrollment, including related payment due and grade level for 2017-2018 school year.

Re-Registration fees are applied to each student registered and are due at the time of re-registration. *A reduced Re-Registration Fee Rate is being offered to those students who are registered by February 28, 2017.* You must complete this process by this date to receive the reduced re-registration rate (after this date the fee is \$100).

Be sure to use the link in each email you receive in order to see the correct information for the 2017-2018 school year. Payments are to be made per student. Thank you for your commitment to Catholic education and for continuing to trust SDSC with the education and growth of your children!

If for some reason they do not complete this minimum requirement at home, they will be expected to stay after school each week to complete it.
