Please note that there will be NO Busing for Wappingers and Arlington this Tuesday, November 2nd.

Arrival Reminders:

- Pull forward as far as possible along the sidewalk in front of the school.
- > Minimize space between vehicles.
- > Students must exit vehicles from the passenger's side of the vehicle by the sidewalk.
- > School begins at 8:00 a.m. Please be on time.

Dismissal Reminders:

- Dismissal will begin promptly after prayers at 2:45 p.m.
- ➤ Please line up in the dismissal lanes in the large parking lot in front of the convent.
- Be sure to have a LARGE sign with last name on the passenger's side of the windshield
- Please minimize space between vehicles there will be more than 100 vehicles on campus for pick-up!
- For safety, students must enter vehicles on the passenger's side of the vehicle.
