

Shoes, Jewelry and Hair


- ✓ Closed-toe black/dark shoes. **No sneakers**. Girls may wear shoes with a small heel, but must be able to walk in them comfortably.

Healthcare Reminders

Illnesses are on the rise in the local community and at SDSC. If you need Covid Test kits, please let us know. We ask that you help us keep our students, faculty, staff and families healthy by adhering to the following:

- •Do not send a child to school with a fever. Students should be fever free for a full 24 hours without medication prior to returning to school. As per the Board of Health, any child with a temperature of 100 or higher has a fever. Please be mindful if your student has a temperature of 99-100, this could be the beginning of an illness, and it may be worth a day of rest to not worsen or prolong the illness.
- •If a student has been vomiting, the student must be symptom-free for a full 24 hours prior to returning to school.

• If children come to school and they are symptomatic everyone else at risk of contracting an illness.
